## HOW TO ASK FOR HELP

### Decide what the issue really is.

- What is happening?
- How long have you had this problem?
- Who is it an issue for?

### Gather together documents and information.

#### -Medical Information:

- \* doctors and dentists' names and addresses
- \* medical records / card
- \* immunization records

#### - Legal Papers

- \* birth certificates
- \* Social Security cards
- \* divorce / custody papers

#### - Income Verification

- \* pay stubs or unemployment statement
- \* W-2's or tax form
- \* verification from Department of Job and Family Services or the Social Security office

### Check the Resource Directory and contact the right agency for help.

- Be clear about what you want.
- Have your documents together.
- Write down the date, who you talked to, and what you are told.
- Repeat the information so you know it is correct.

### If the agency cannot help you, ask who can. *Be persistent!*

You may have to make several contacts and talk to many people.
